

The Islamic Center of Tucson is excited to announce Phase I of our in-person re-opening process. Below are the guidelines and policies ICT's Board of Directors saw fit after reviewing with professionals and incorporating practices from other Islamic Centers across the country. **These guidelines are subject to change at any time.** ICT Administrators will closely monitor the local COVID-19 spread, effectiveness of safety measures, and adherence to the guidelines and policies below. As we review these items, and seek additional guidance, we may choose to expand or shrink the entry limit. We ask Allah to protect our community, our masjid, and our souls. May Allah grant his mercy on this community.

Guideline and Policy:

- The Islamic Center of Tucson will allow a maximum entry of 10 people at once.
- Face mask must be worn for the whole duration at ICT. Please come with your own face mask.
- Face Masks must be worn correctly to fully cover the mouth and nose
- No Jumma prayer will be held during phase I
- Those inside the ICT will observe social distancing at all times (this includes separation during prayer)
- A disposable prayer mat (small sheet to protect the face and hands from the floor) will be used during prayer. This will be provided by ICT.
- Restrooms and Wudu area will be unavailable. Please ensure you come to ICT prepared with Wudu.
- The following types of people are not permitted:
 - Anyone over the age of 65
 - Anyone under the age of 18
 - Anyone with an underlying health condition with the CDC identifies as a risk factor for COVID-19
 - Anyone who has been exposed to someone with COVID-19 or has a fever or other symptoms
- ICT will be used for strictly prayer. No social gatherings or events will be observed in the ICT.
- Entry will be granted on a "first come, first serve basis". In the event we have consistent high attendance, an online registration will be made available where you must register prior to attending.
- ICT Administrator(s) on site will provide guidance and direction. Only Administrators will have access to the ICT building and will grant 10-person entry.
- Anyone failing to follow these guidelines will be warned once and a second occurrence will cause them to lose entry privileges for the remainder of this phase.
